LIBRARY PROGRAMS

Live Program Sessions: any planned event which introduces the group attending to library services or which provides information to participants. Program sessions may cover use of the library, library services, or library tours. Program sessions may also provide cultural, recreational, or educational information.

INCLUDE

- All program sessions that are sponsored or co-sponsored by the library. For a program session to be sponsored or co-sponsored by the library, the library must contribute financial resources or staff time toward the program session.
- Both on-site and off-site program sessions.
- Live-streamed virtual (synchronous) program sessions sponsored or co-sponsored by the library.
- Program sessions with attendance of zero or one if they were intended for a group.

EXCLUDE

- Program sessions sponsored by other groups that use library facilities.
- Offsite outreach efforts that do not otherwise meet the definition of a program session.
- Activities delivered on a one-to-one basis, rather than to a group.
- Passive or self-directed activities that do not occur at a scheduled time.

When reporting attendees count total number of attendees regardless of the age. A children's program attended by 10 children and 10 adults is counted as 20, not as 10.

Live, virtual programs are conducted via a Web conferencing or webinar platform with an audience in real-time. Recordings of program content include video or audio recordings created by a library staff person (or other party sponsored by the library) and posted to a video or audio hosting platform for the audience to view or list to on-demand.

If a program is hybrid (i.e., in-person and virtual) then report it as in-person. Do not double count.
